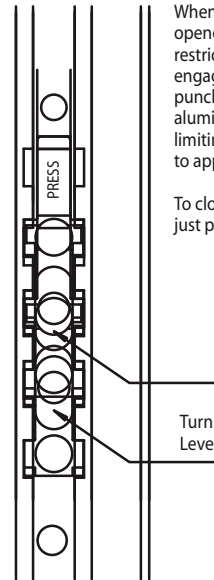

When the window is closed the restrictor is depressed below the aluminium track and is not engaged.

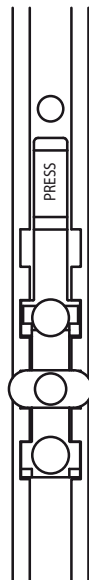

When the window is opened the integral restrictor will move and engage into the pre punched slots in the aluminium track thus limiting the movement to approx. 100mm.

To close the window just pull closed.

Figure 3 illustrates the position of the integral restrictor when the window is open at 100mm. If hold open is required the turn lever must be rotated 90° so it is horizontal as illustrated. Turn lever must be returned to the vertical position as in Fig. 2 before closing the window. To close the window just pull closed.

To open the window past the first restricted position open as in Fig. 2.

*If an additional blocking device is fitted this should be removed with the key provided.

Ensure the turn lever is in the correct position (as Fig. 2). Press down the restrictor into the aluminium track whilst controlling the window. Once released push until the restrictor engages into the second pre punched slots in the aluminium track.

To close the window just pull closed.

*Any additional blocking device should be reinstalled before closing.
